SECTION 3 - HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW

Liquid. Color as per product name. Causes skin and eye irritation. Contains material which can cause cancer.

POTENTIAL HEALTH EFFECTS

Target organs: Eyes, skin, respiratory system.

Potential acute health effects:

 E_{Ves} : Causes eye irritation. May cause conjunctivitis, irritation, and inflammation of mucous membranes. May cause

burning sensation, redness and tearing (watering). Possible severe irritation.

Skin: Irritating to skin. Possible irritation, defatting or dermatitis (rash). Components of the product may be absorbed into the

body through the skin. May cause central nervous system depression.

Inhalation: Can cause irritation of the respiratory tract. Prolonged exposure to vapours may be harmful to health. If higher

concentrations are inhaled, additional symptoms may include coughing, shortness of breath, headache, nausea, vomiting, dizziness, drowsiness and other central nervous system effects. May cause mucous membrane irritation. Other adverse effects: Asphyxia. Severe lung irritation or lung damage, loss of appetite. Sanding and grinding dusts may be harmful if inhaled. Contains particles which may cause lung damage if inhaled in large quantities. No. 5350:

Pneumoconiosis, or "dusty lung" disease, may result from chronic exposure to any dust.

Ingestion: Lung aspiration hazard. This product may be aspirated (inhaled) into the lungs during ingestion. May cause lung

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Potential chronic health effects:

SECTION 4 - FIRST AID MEASURES

Inhalation: If breathed in, move person into fresh air. If breathing has stopped, give artificial respiration.

If breathing is difficult, give oxygen by qualified medical personnel only. Seek immediate

SECTION 7 - HANDLING AND STORAGE
